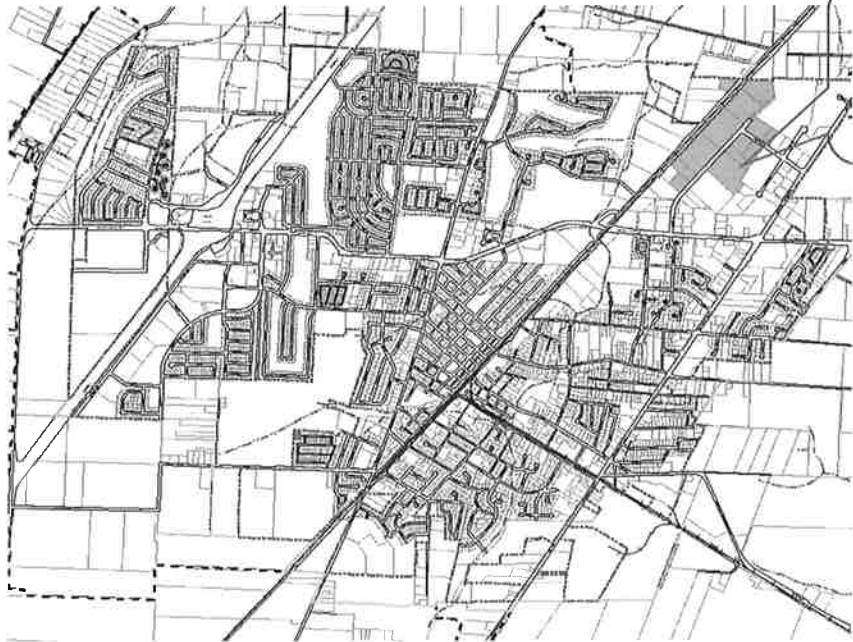




Marijuana Dispensaries and Related Business Activity

- Does Woodburn allow marijuana dispensaries?
Yes, dispensaries are allowed.
- Where can dispensaries be located?
Woodburn allows dispensaries, as a special use, in the Light Industrial (LI) and Industrial Park (IP) zones, subject to locational standards.
- What are the locational standards?
Dispensaries shall not be located within 1,000 feet of schools, child care facilities, parks, residentially designated properties or another dispensary.
- With all of these locational limitations for dispensaries, where are they allowed?
The map below illustrates what properties in Woodburn meet the locational standards; but basically, they are allowed near the intersection of Industrial Avenue and Progress Way.
- What other limitations apply?
Dispensaries must meet all State standards and may not exceed 3,000 square feet in size.
- Are there other standards for dispensaries?
Yes, the Woodburn Municipal Ordinance has additional standards for dispensaries:

- Are there licensing requirements for dispensaries?
Yes, the Municipal Ordinance has local licensing requirements.

- **Are other marijuana-related businesses allowed in Woodburn?**
Growing and processing marijuana is allowed in the industrial zones in Woodburn.
- **Are marijuana-related businesses subject to state and local standards?**
Yes. Marijuana-related businesses must be licensed through the State of Oregon and must meet local requirements.
